Construction

- Polyester and high quality anti-osmotic resin
- Hull, deck and coachroof laminated by infusion
- Balsa core hull, solid laminate under waterline, white gelcoat
- Balsa core bridge deck and deck
- Laminated marine plywood bulkheads

Deck layout

TRANSOM

- Hot/cold deck shower on starboard
- S/s telescopic swim ladder with fixed handle on starboard
- Storage on the side of the transom (port and starboard)

AFT COCKPIT

- Large cockpit usable as a deck saloon, protected by a hard top bimini
- U-shaped bench seat to port with storage locker
- Gas locker (2 bottles of 10 kg / 22 lbs)
- Removable polyester cockpit table 8/10 people
- Large storage locker with possibility to install option like icemaker and synthetic resin countertop
- 1 Lounger with locker in the seat, to starboard
- Waste bin with upper access and lateral door on port side
- Storage locker with top access (70 L / 18 US gal) and scupper on port side
- Polyester fiddle anti-runoff on the sides of the cockpit

HELM STATION

- Composite staircases for access from the cockpit
- Double helm seat
- Leather covered s/s steering wheel 800mm (31") diameter
- Engine throttle and panel
- Console for screen and instrumentation

MATTRESSES AND UPHOLSTERY

- Standard upholstery as indicated on Lagoon sample book
- Synthetic fabrics adapted to marine environment:
 - washable (40°C / 104°F)
 - U.V. resistant
 - water repellent, with anti-stain treatment
- Blackout curtains in the cabins and saloon
- Mosquito screen and blinds for deck hatches

SALOON

- Sliding door and window with aluminum lock for the access to the cockpit, can be locked open or closed
- Large varnished saloon table exchangeable with the polyester table from the cockpit (and the low table in option) and convertible in berth
- 6-person L-shaped bench seat to starboard
- Lockers under the bench
- Various high and low storage on the starboard cupboard in front of the table (option TV / option second fridge or freezer)
- Storage niche on the side edge (*essential equipment*)
- Fabric covered steel mast support strut
- 2 opening portholes in the front window
- 1 opening porthole in the port window

- Large instrument console with panel to install the electronics
- Stool
- Desk with flaps
- 2 storage niches

- U-shaped galley, to port
- Corian® Warm Grey countertop
- Double s/s sink with hot/cold mixer tap

- 1 cupboard with wardrobe (upper part) and shelves (lower part) – inboard side

- Bookshelves on 2 levels
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- 1 opening porthole
- 1 fixed hull window in Plexiglas white silkscreen printing
